

# TURNED NECK SWEATER



## Size: 12 (16)

**NOTE:** figures in brackets () refer to larger size. Where only one figure is given this refers to both sizes. **Skill Level:** intermediate

### How much yarn:

g 500 (600) of Feeling yarn, in wine red shade no. 12947 **Needles:** Pair of 3.75 mm (no. 9) knitting needles A double-pointed (Dp) needle **Sewing needle:** Yarn needle with rounded point

#### STITCHES

Tubular stitch

CABLE RIB: (worked on multiple of 10 sts)

**Row 1(RS):** \* P2, K6, P2; rep from \*. **Row 2:** \* K2, P6, K2; rep from \*. **Rows 3 and 4:** rep Rows 1 and 2. **Row 5:** \* P2, 6 Left crossed stitches (= place next 3 sts onto Dp needle, on frontside, K next 3 sts, K3 from Dp needle), P2; rep from \*. **Row 6:** as Row 2. Rep Rows 1- 6 throughout.

CABLE-AND-CROSS MOTIF: (worked on multiple of 20 sts) **Row 1(RS):** \* 5 Right crossed stitches (= place next 2 sts onto Dp needle, on backside, K next 3 sts, P2 from Dp needle), 5 Left crossed stitches (= place next 3 sts onto Dp needle, on frontside, P next 2 sts, K3 from Dp needle); rep from \*.

**Row 2 and following even rows:** Knit the K sts and purl the P sts. **Row 3:** K3, \* P4, 6 Left crossed stitches; rep from \* until last 7 sts, P4, K3. **Row 5:** \* 5 Left crossed stitches; 5 Right crossed stitches; rep from \*.

**Row 7:** \* P2, 6 Left crossed sts, P2; rep from \*. **Row 9:** \* P2, K6, P2; rep from \*.

**Row 11:** \* P2, K6, P2; rep from \*. **Row 13:** \* P2, K6, P4, 6 Left crossed sts, P2; rep from \*.

**Row 15:** \* P2, K6, P2; rep from \*. **Row 17:** \* P2, K6, P2; rep from \*. **Row 19:** \* P2, 6 Left crossed sts, P2; rep from \*.

**Row 20:** Knit the K sts and purl the P sts. Rep Rows 1-20 throughout.

#### TENSION

33 sts and 33 rows measure 10 cm square over patt with 3.75 mm (no. 9) needles.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** with 3.75 mm (no.9) needles cast on 140 (160) sts. Work 4 rows in tubular st and 24 (30) rows in Cable rib. Then work in Cable-and-Cross Motif. When work measures 31(39) cm from beg, shape raglan armholes. Cont to work in Cableand-Cross Motif, dec 1 st at each end every alternate row 15 (10) times and every 4th row 5 (10) times. When work measures 15(18) cm from shape raglan armholes cast off rem 100 (120) sts.

Front: work as Back.

**Sleeves:** with 3.75 mm (no.9) needles cast on 100 (120) sts. Work 4 rows in tubular st and 24 (30) rows in Cable rib. Then work in Cable-and-Cross Motif. When work measures 37 (45) cm from beg, shape raglan armholes. Cont to work in Cableand-Cross Motif, dec 1 st at each end every alternate row 15 (10) times and every 4th row 5 (10) times. When work measures 15(18) cm from shape raglan armholes cast off rem 60 (80) sts.

**Collar:** sew raglan seams excluding Right-hand seam on Back. With 3.75 mm and RS of work facing, pick up and K 100 (120) sts across Back, 60 (80) sts across Left Sleeve, 100 (120) sts across Front, 60 (80) sts across Right Sleeve. There are 320 (400) sts. Starting on WS work 40 rows in Cable-and-Cross Motif. Then work 4 rows in tubular st. Using needle yarn, cast off grafting in kitcheners stitch.

#### FINISHING

With yarn needle, sew rem raglan seam and collar seam. Then sew side and sleeve seams.
